Your data

The Three Borough Shared Service collects, uses and stores (*processes*) information about foster carers, other members of their household and possibly extended family and friends, in line with GDPR. There are various reasons why we may process your information, but all will be because of our statutory or public duty to support you or any children and young people that may live with you or being considered to live with you. Such reasons include, but are not limited to:

- providing advice and guidance to prospective or approved carers
- providing support and training to foster carers
- processing foster carer applications
- assessing suitability to become a foster carer
- developing and improving our services
- ensuring that foster carers receive payments
- complete statistical returns to Government bodies

The fostering Service is the host local authority for Westminster City Council & The Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea.
