Offer whilst waiting for the PfA Team – What Happens While You Wait

Who Checks Referrals?

Every day, someone from our team checks new referrals (requests for help). This happens in the morning and throughout the day.

⊗ What Happens Next?

Once we've looked at your referral:

- You'll be added to our system and a manager will put a comment on your record about what needs to happen next
- Your name goes into a list called the **Allocations Tray**.
- We also add you to a special spreadsheet that helps us decide how quickly you need support.

How Do We Decide Who Needs Help First?

The spreadsheet uses colours and numbers to show who needs help the most:

- Red = Urgent
- Amber = Medium
- Green = Lower priority

Sometimes, we change the colour if we think someone needs help sooner. For example, if someone is nearly 18 and has serious safety concerns, we might move them to **Red** even if the system says **Amber**.

Keeping in Touch

While you're waiting:

- A social worker will check in with you however often you would like. This could be weekly, monthly and can change depending on what you need at the time.
- They'll ask how you're doing and if anything has changed.
- If something important comes up, we might change your priority.
- We can call, text or email you depending on what you would like us to do.

What Do We Do With the Info?

- We write notes about our chats and updates in your file.
- If something urgent happens, we'll act on it straight away to support you.
