

Risk Analysis

Reflect on child's age, gender, ethnicity, disability and religion. Consider Household Composition, wider family and significant others. Who are the wider professionals involved? What are the presenting issues?

Are there any child protection risks- what the evidence to support this is?

What are the family resilience and protective factors that surround the child?

What is the current reason for involvement, including considering historic context?

What are the multi-agency perspectives?

How can we affect and affect change and positive outcomes for the child?

What is the daily lived experience of the child?

What is the parents' motivation/capacity to effect change and sustain?

Consider chronology of social care/multi-agency involvement. Are there any previously achieved outcomes?

What is the family background and are there any significant events.

What is the level of risk/need? What are the identified risks and or strengths? Indicate vulnerabilities. What is the impact on the child?

What is your plan and recommendations, what needs to happen next?
