

Young Person Homeless or at Risk of Homelessness - HOMELESS TONIGHT



When is a Young Person Homeless?

A young person can be homeless if they are: staying with friends or family or sofa surfing; staying IN Nightstop; squatting; at risk of violence or abuse in their home; living in poor conditions that affect their health; living apart from their family because they don't have somewhere to live together.

If at any point there are concerns for the young person's safety, possible CE risks, if there are safeguarding concerns or if the young person is at risk of homelessness, a referral to the Safeguarding Hub must be made.
