

The person who runs the meeting is called the 'Conference Chair'. The 'Conference Chair' makes sure that everyone at the meeting has a chance to have their say about what they think is going well and not going so well. The 'Conference Chair' then helps everyone at the meeting to put a plan together to try and make things safer or better for the child.
