Leaving Care Grant TV/ Connections	Statutory Requirement	250.00	One of Payment	Inc TV licence, gas/electric cooker W. Machine connection.
Leaving Care Grant Furniture & Equipment	Statutory Requirement	£1500.00	One of Payment	Moving into permanent accommodation. Furniture and Equipment
Subsistence	Statutory Requirement	£57.35	Weekly until 18	Ongoing reduced to £10.00 if in Youth Offending Institute.
Clothing	Statutory Requirement	£10.00	Weekly until 18	Ongoing though not for young people in foster care this is covered in allowance.
Travel	Statutory Requirement	Depending on location	Weekly/Monthly	When attending education/training only. Evidence to be produced
Festive period	Statutory Requirement	£50.00	Annually	16 to 18 only Depending on what faith the young person follows i.e.: Ede , Xmas
Birthday	Statutory Requirement	£25.00	Annually	16 and 17. Check they are not already getting from Residential unit. Vouchers Only
18 th Birthday	Statutory Requirement	£50.00	Annually	18 Only last payment. Cash or vouchers depending on young person ability to manage money.
Photos	Statutory Requirement	£5.00	One of payment	To be used for application forms etc.
Birth Certificate	Statutory Requirement	£10.00	One of Payment	For young people who do not have a certificate and need to be purchased. 16-21 year olds.
Government University Bursary	Statutory Requirement	£2000.00	Divided up Over three years	Young people over the age of 18 Enrolled on a university course / Higher Education.
