Process For Serious Case Incidents Which Require Notification to The Child Safeguarding Practice Review Panel

Where a local authority in England knows or suspects that a child has been abused or neglected, the local authority must notify the Child Safeguarding Practice Review panel if

a) the child dies or is seriously harmed in the local authority's area

or

b) while normally resident in the local authority's area, the child dies or is seriously harmed outside England.
