

The Review of a Supervision Order Flowchart

At any point during the order where there is considered to be an increasing risk of harm a strategy meeting should be convened

Supervision Order Granted (12 Months)

The IRO will transfer the case over to the LCPP upon the making of a SO

SW transfers Supervision Plan into the C&F Progress Plan Step and commences C&FP Meeting under the CiN Framework.
The Danger Statement is to be updated to reflect the harm at the point of the order being made. The Safety Goal, Scaling Question will be added to the C&F Progress Plan and will include working with the family to ensure they are supported by the plan.

LCPP convenes the initial SO review at 28 day point and can assist the social worker to create the child and family progress plan from the supervision order plan agreed in Court.

If a 6-Month Supervision Order has been granted. Team Manager attends the Meeting

3- Month Point the LCPP Chairs the formal review meeting the PS will attend and updates the TM

N.B: The SW should keep the LCPP updated of progress in between reviews

6- Month Point the LCPP chairs the formal review meeting. The PS will attend the C&FP Meeting and updates the TM

In between the formal reviews the Social Worker should be holding regular child and family progress meetings

9- Month Point the LCPP Chairs the formal review meeting which the TM will attend N.B. Prior to the TM attending the Review meeting, a C&F Assessment should be completed to assist their decision making

Supervision Order can lapse on the expiry of the Order:

End of SO but risk of harm to the Child remains

Step Down to TAC

Continue under CIN

Close

Plan to return the case to Support Panel to Seek agreement to seek Legal Advice/LPM

N.B: At any point throughout the duration of the Supervision Order, if the concerns are deemed to be so significant, consideration should be given to seeking legal advice with a view of returning the matter to Court.

Return to Court to extend the Order or Seek an Alternative Order
