Problematic Parental Drug and Alcohol use Including Young Parents

Professionals from any agency become aware of a Child/unborn child in an environment where there is parental or other significant person(s) who has problematic drug or alcohol use. Remain mindful that adult and children's services should provide a co-ordinated whole family approach.
