Self-Harm (Including self induced poisoning) Pathway for under 16's

Young person presents at A&E

Assessed/triaged by A&E staff

Consult with CAMHS as soon as possible to avoid delay in assessment if no medical treatment required.

No medical attention and fit for assessment

Refer to CAMHS crisis and home treatment service

Phone triage with parent/carer, young person and A&E.

Low risk/ low intent

Send home with keep safe plan and follow up within 13 hours Concerns re: risk
High risk face to
face assessment by
CAMHS crisis and
home treatment
service

Medical treatment required

Admit to paediatric ward if requiring treatment

In the case of young people with safeguarding and complex social care issues, consider admission for safety reasons until an alternative placement can be arranged.

Refer to CAMHS crisis when medically fit for assessment

Liaise with CAMHS for support re: mental health needs

Discharge home with keep safe plan and follow up

Requires inpatient admission

Agree for young person to be kept safe in hospital while mental health inpatient bed located.

CAMHS crisis and home treatment service is available between 9am and 7pm

N.B. commissioned response times are four hours via telephone and 13 hours face to face.
