- Reassure that they will be informed of and involved in all stages of the process
- Provide with details of the CSC contact if appropriate following contact

NO FURTHER ACTION

In the event that it is agreed that there is **no safeguarding concern**, this must be documented by all agencies and fed back to the parents/ carers No single agency should make this decision.

MORE ACTION IS REQUIRED

Where there are concerns that abuse needs to be ruled out, CSC will contact the Police Child Abuse Investigation Unit ("CAIU")



A STRATEGY

DISCUSSION Will be convened by CSC and involve the referrer, CAIU and the Community on call paediatrician for advise. IF a medical is required, this will be conducted under the LSCB Paediatric Safeguarding Medicals Procedure

N.B. DOCUMENT: Ensure all conversations and findings are clearly documented with the date and time and who provided you with the information. All marks on a BODY MAP including the size, shape, colour and the date and time of the examination
