Pathway Planning Timeline

15 ½ years old

- Apply for a National Insurance Number on behalf of young person.

15 ½ - 15 ¾ years old

- IRO will trigger the Pathway Needs Assessment following the CYPIC review that takes place after their 15th birthday
- Social Worker to undertake Pathway Needs Assessment with young person
- Needs assessment to be completed by 16 years old.

16 - 16 1/2 years old

- Pathway Plan is developed and co produced with young person
- Begin discussions about options and pathways out of care
- Consider advice and guidance from pathway accommodation officer
- Ensure Staying Put has been discussed with carers
- Undertake pathway life skills booklet with young person/ carers
- Ensure that young person has a copy of/ access to the Local Offer

17 years old

- Referral to Pathway Team to ensure matched allocation to worker by 17 ½ years old
- If it is felt that an early allocation would be purposeful and meaningful for the young person this needs to be made clear on the referral form.
- The Pathway plan should identify the specific areas that Pathway can support with. A referral will not be accepted without a completed Pathway plan.

17 ½ years old

- Pathway worker is allocated
- Case discussion and introductions arranged

17 ¾ vears

- 3 way case supervision with allocated Social Worker, Pathway Worker and Team Managers.

old

- Case transfer to Pathway Team
- Case summary up to date
- Pathway Plan reviewed and assigned to Pathway Worker
- Care leaver contact added and assigned to Pathway Worker
- 18 years old - Chronology updated
 - End of accommodation workstep completed
 - All outstanding Mosaic worksteps completed/ deleted
